## **CECIL LEITCH MEMORIAL TROPHY**

This trophy was donated by Silloth-on-Solway Golf Club in 1979, in memory of Miss Cecil Leitch's views on 5 club golf. The following rules shall exist. It is the wish of the donors that this Memorial Trophy shall not be a fund raising event.

- 1. Open to all paid up members of the C.L.C.G.A. who have a certified active CONGU handicap.
- 2. The competition shall be 18 holes medal stroke play.
- 3. The entry fee shall be at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 4. Only 5 clubs may be taken on the course, one of which must be a putter.
- 5. The qualifying rounds shall be played at each club by 31<sup>st</sup> May.
- 6. Where possible competitors will **not** be drawn with fellow club members.
- 7. The players with the best and second best net scores at each club shall qualify for the final. Their names to be submitted to the County Competition's Secretary no later than 4<sup>th</sup> June, who will then finalise the arrangements and notify the players. In the event of a qualifier not being able to play, the next in order of score may be used as a replacement.
- 8. The value of the prizes for the winner, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Nett of the final shall be at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 9. The player with the best net score at the final to hold the CECIL LEITCH MEMORIAL TROPHY for one year.
- 10. In the event of a tie, the result shall be determined by a count back over the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes, followed by the first 9.
- 11. This is a non-counting competition for handicap under rule-4 of the Rules of Golf.
- 12. Handicap certificates may be required.
- 13. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the competition will be referred to the Executive Committee, whose decision is final.
- 14. The Executive Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the rules.
- 15. Ride-on buggies and Distance Measuring Devices See separate rule that covers all competitions.
