

## **CUMBRIA LADIES' COUNTY GOLF ASSOCIATION**

## **COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP**

- 1. Open to all paid up members of the C.L.C.G.A. who have a certified active CONGU handicap.
- 2. To be played in rotation on a recognised County Green, approved by the County Handicap Advisor.
- 3. The competition shall be played over three days in the following format:
  - Day 1 36 holes medal strokeplay competition. The best Sixteen gross scores qualify for the CUMBRIA LADIES' CHAMPIONSHIP. These qualifiers will be put into an automatic draw. The best scratch score over 36 holes to be awarded the RELPH TROPHY. Prizes awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Nett and best Nett Veterans.
  - Day 2 Morning The first round of the Championship. Sixteen Qualifiers match play.
  - Day 2 Afternoon The second round of the Championship. Eight Qualifiers match play.
  - Day 3 Morning Semi Finals of the Championship. Four Qualifiers match play.
  - Day 3 Afternoon Final of the Championship. Two Qualifiers match play.
  - Day 3 Prizes awarded to The County Champion, Runner up and two semi-finalists.
- 4. The entry fee shall be at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 5. Entries must be submitted to the Honorary Competition Secretary by the due date.
- 6. Where possible competitors will **not** be drawn with fellow club members.
- 7. In the event of a tie, the result shall be determined by a count back over the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes, followed by the first 9, on the second 18 hole card.
- 8. No competitor may take both scratch and handicap prize in one event or win more than one prize.
- 9. Handicap certificates may be required.
- 10. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the competition will be referred to the Executive Committee, whose decision is final.
- 11. The Executive Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the rules.
- 12. Ride-on buggies and Distance Measuring Devices See separate rule that covers all competitions.

## REFEREES WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR THE SEMI-FINALS AND THE FINAL
