

**RULES FOR THE USE OF RIDE-ON BUGGIES**  
**and**  
**DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES**

These rules apply to all competitions, without exception.

1. A ride-on motorised buggy can only be used by competitors, if permission has been sought from the Honorary Competition Secretary.  
**However in the County Championships a buggy will only be allowed if the person is permanently disabled or can produce a certificate of temporary disability for the duration of the competition.**
2. This must be sought before the day of the competition.
3. A valid medical certificate will only be necessary if the Honorary Competition Secretary requests it.
4. The host club must also agree to the use of the buggy.
5. The buggy can only be used to transport the player, her golf equipment, and her trolley puller.
6. Distance Measuring Devices – a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play, e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc., the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 of the Rules of Golf, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
