

CUMBRIA LADIES' COUNTY GOLF ASSOCIATION

ONE DAY TEAM TROPHY COMPETITION

- 1. Restricted to Clubs affiliated the County and open to all paid up members of the C.L.C.G.A. who have a certified active WHS handicap index
- 2. Each Club may enter a team of five players, whose names with current handicap indexes must be submitted by a designated date to the Honorary Competition Secretary. Handicap certificates must be produced at the event.
- 3. The competition shall be 18 holes medal stroke play with 95% allowance of Course Handicap
- 4. Entries and entry fees to be received by the Council Meeting. A draw for the participating clubs to be made at that meeting by the Honorary Competition Secretary and the Ladies County Captain. The entry fee shall be decided by the Executive committee.
- 5. The team shall play in Course handicap order, lowest first. Failure to observe this rule will result in disqualification of the team.
- 6. Failure to appear on the first tee at the appointed time will result in disqualification of the player, unless due to circumstances beyond the control of the player. Any disqualification of a player shall not disqualify the whole team.
- 7. The team returning the lowest aggregate of four scores to hold the Scratch Trophy for one year. The Team returning the lowest four nett scores shall hold the Handicap Trophy for one year. In the event of a tie, the results shall be determined by a count back over the 9, 6, 3 and 1 holes, followed by the first 9 on the fourth card. Should one team return the best gross and best nett, they shall hold the Gross Trophy, and the second lowest aggregate nett score will hold the Handicap Trophy. The Individual Plates will be awarded to the best individual gross and best individual nett scores.
- 8. If the weather conditions are extremely bad, the Captains of the Teams timed to play first, the organisers, the host Captain and host Secretary, shall decide the availability of play.
- 9. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the competition will be referred to the Executive Committee, whose decision is final.
- 10. The Executive Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the rules.
- 11. Ride-on buggies and Distance Measuring Devices See separate rule that covers all competitions.
