OLIVE COULTHARD CUP formerly BRONZE CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1. Open to all paid up members of the C.L.C.G.A. who have a certified active CONGU handicap of 20.5-54.
- 2. The competition shall be played over 18 holes stableford.
- 3. The entry fee shall be decided by the Executive Committee.
- 4. The player with the best gross score to hold the COULTHARD CUP for one year. The Best Stableford to be awarded, 1st 2nd, 3rd prizes.(Dependent on entries)
- 5. Players who are 65 years plus, may play for the Veterans prize. (Dependent on entries)
- 6. Where possible competitors will **not** be drawn with fellow club members.
- 7. In the event of a tie, the result shall be determined by a count back over the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes, followed by the first 9.
- 8. No competitor may take more than one prize.
- 9. Handicap certificates may be requested.
- 10. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the competition will be referred to the Executive Committee, whose decision is final.
- 11. The Executive Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the rules.
- 12. Ride-on buggies and Distance measuring devices See the separate rule that covers all competitions.

THE OLIVE COULTHARD TEAM TROPHY

- 1. The Trophy to be played for at the Bronze Championship.
- 2. A team to comprise of four nominated players.
- 3. A Club may enter more than one team.
- 4. The Trophy will be awarded to the Team with the best three aggregate stableford scores.
- 5. The entry fee shall be decided by the Executive Committee.
- 6. In the event of a tie of scores, the fourth card will be used as a decider. The stableford score of the fourth card will be added to other cards and, in the event of a further tie, the result will be decided on the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes, followed by the first 9.
- 13. Ride-on buggies and Distance measuring devices See the separate rule that covers all competitions.
