

Temp guidance when playing junior girls in the teams. To be added to the “**Cumbria Ladies County Association Inter Club League Match Play Rules & Regulations**” as an appendix until they can be approved at the Autumn meeting and added to the Rules & Regulations

Guidelines for Juniors playing in the leagues

- a) The opposing team Captain & appropriate league secretary **MUST** be informed as soon as possible prior to the match date
- b) The club fielding the junior is responsible for the **safety** of the junior and **MUST** ensure all relevant Junior Safe Guarding procedures are adhered to
(See appendix 5 & 6 of the CYP Safeguarding Policy on the CLCGA website)
- c) The club fielding the junior is responsible to ensure the safety of the junior and provide an Accompanying Adult for all juniors U16 (8 - 15yrs).
 - I. The Accompanying Adult is there as an observer for safeguarding purposes only and should **NOT** get involved with golf decisions at any time.
 - II. The Accompanying Adult should maintain a distance from the players, whilst ensuring that they are able to monitor any inappropriate verbal or physical interaction from either player.
 - III. Anything untoward should be noted in writing as soon as possible and submitted to the County Safeguarding Officer,

- d) If a team selects a junior but fails to adhere to the above rules and regulations the junior will not be allowed to play and will forfeit her game and her game point
